What is Recyclable?

ALL ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY, CLEAN & DRY

PLASTIC



OK to put in

- Empty Beverage Bottles with Caps On
- Buckets
- Large Plastic Tubs
- Empty Laundry Detergent Bottles
- Plastic Flower Pots & Trays
- Plastic Toys
- Rigid Plastic Greater Than 6"

NOT OK to put in

- Styrofoam
- Plastic Bags & Film Plastic
- Saran Wrap, Pallet Wrap
- Food Bags & Wrappers
- Flexible Plastic Wrapping
- Plastic Labeled Compostable or Biodegradable
- Yogurt Cups
- Clear Plastic Produce or Food Containers
- Plastic Straws, Cups & Utensils

PAPER & CARDBOARD



OK to put in

- Paper Bags
- Non Waxed Cardboard
- Cereal Boxes & Paperboard
- Computer & Office Paper
- Envelopes
- Junk Mail
- Newspaper
- Packing or Kraft Paper
- Phonebooks

NOT OK to put in

- Paper Food & Beverage Containers
- Milk Cartons, Tetrapack or Aseptic Containers
- Pizza Boxes
- Waxed Cardboard

METAL



OK to put in

- Aluminium Cans
- Aluminium Foil & Trays
- Caps & Lids From Bottles, Jars & Steel Cans
- Empty Paint Cans
- Empty Spray Cans
- Scrap Metal & Metal Parts

GLASS



OK to put in

- Bottles
- Jars

NOT OK to put in

- Kitchen Glassware and Other Tempered Glass
- Window Glass

BATTERIES ARE ACCEPTABLE IN A SEALED PLASTIC BAG PLACED ON TOP OF THE RECYCLE CART
