Save the date for the Santa Barbara Earth Day Festival at Alameda Park on Saturday, April 27, and Sunday, April 28, 2024, hosted by Community Environmental Council (CEC) and CarpEvents. The theme of this year's festival is Planet vs Plastics with the aim to advocate for widespread awareness on the health risks of plastics, phasing out single use plastics, and pushing for a strong UN Treaty on Plastic Pollution by the end of the year. This free event is broken into themed-zones including kids' activities, food and drink, and an ecofriendly marketplace. One of the longest-running Earth Day celebrations in the country, there will be two full days of live music and entertainment and the largest Green Car Show on the Central Coast. FREE for residents in the cities of Santa Barbara and Goleta, and in the unincorporated areas of Santa Barbara County. Residents are required to show proof of residency by bringing one of the following at every visit: driver's license, utility bill, or car registration.

- Up to 15 gallons (net liquid) or 125 pounds per trip.
- Fee for business waste call ahead for more info and to schedule an appointment.

Updated Bulky Item Pickup Services

The City of Goleta recently amended the franchise agreement for solid waste handling services with MarBorg Industries, which includes updates to existing bulky item pickup services. Both single-family homes and multi-family residences can enjoy **FREE** bulky item collections throughout the year. Goleta single-family residences are entitled to 4 free bulky waste pickups (5 items maximum per cleanup) each year. Goleta multi-family residences are entitled to collections matching the number of dwelling units in the complex annually, at no extra cost. Each dwelling unit's annual collection accommodates 5 bulky items or boxes. **All cleanups must be scheduled in advance.**





If you pay for individual trash service, you are eligible for these clean-ups. If you pay for trash service through an association or complex, bulky waste cleanups may be scheduled by each tenant or the property manager. Please call us ASAP at 805-963-1852 to schedule your pickup as reservations book quickly!
